Dear Parent(s) / Guardian(s):

Greetings from Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish and St. Anthony of Padua Cathedral. My name is Fr. John Lemire and I am the Pastor of both Parishes since the beginning of July. While each Parish retains its individual identity and way of life, I am responsible for the pastoral leadership of the two Parishes along with Fr. Michael Sola who serves as my associate.

One of the ways the two Parishes are working together is through a shared sacramental preparation program for young people celebrating the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Communion. All of the preparation will be done at St. Anthony's of Padua Cathedral, but the celebration of the actual Sacrament will take place in the Parish you are registered.

This year marks a significant time in your child's religious life. Children in grade three and up are invited to prepare to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation (or Confession) this fall and the Sacrament of First Eucharist (Communion) during the Easter Season. Only children who have participated in the First Reconciliation preparation will be permitted to celebrate the Sacrament of First Communion.

Through the Sacrament of Reconciliation we believe that God forgives us of our sins and helps us live more and more according to His commandments and gospel values. Through the Sacrament of the Eucharist we believe that Jesus nourishes and strengthens us with His Body and Blood.

Like all of our sacramental preparation in the Parish, we believe that there must be a strong integrated approach. Therefore, our Parish program for preparing for First Reconciliation and First Communion involves three essential components -- school, home, and parish.

To help you in the process, you and your child(ren) are invited to a Parish meeting on **THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 4th at 6:30 P.M. at St. Anthony of Padua Cathedral Hall** (located across the street from the 101 Mall.) This meeting is for parents and candidates for both Parishes. Masking and social distancing will be in effect. **All persons, twelve and older, must be fully vaccinated, show proof of vaccination and photo ID.**

This meeting will be an opportunity to explain the process that you and your child(ren) will be involved in as he / she prepares for the celebration of the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Communion. It is absolutely essential that you attend this meeting and receive an overview of the various stages of the preparation process. Please return the bottom portion of this letter to the school by **Friday, October 29, 2021**.

Over the next months, we invite you to join us in praying in a special way for your child and his or her classmates as they prepare to receive these Sacraments of God's love and healing.
